## I AM THE BEGINNING & THE END: ETERNAL AND EVERLASTING

Genesis 1:1 **In the beginning** God

**Alpha and Omega**: the first and last letters in the Greek alphabet

**I am Alpha and Omega**, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty. Revelation 1:8

**I am Alpha and Omega**, the first and the last: Revelation 1:11

And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful. And he said unto me, It is done. **I am Alpha and Omega**, the beginning and the end. Revelation 21:5-6a

And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be. **I am Alpha and Omega**, the beginning and the end, the first and the last. Revelation 22:12

Remember the former things of old: for I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like me, **Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done**, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure: Isaiah 46:9-10

**Eternal**: that which is before

There is none like unto the God of Jeshurun, who rideth upon the heaven in thy help, and in his excellency on the sky. **The eternal God** is thy refuge, and underneath are the everlasting arms: Deuteronomy 33:26-27a

For the invisible things of him **from the creation of the world** are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even **his eternal power and Godhead**; so that they are without excuse: Romans 1:20

**Now unto the King eternal**, immortal, invisible, the only wise God, be honour and glory for ever and ever. Amen. 1 Timothy 1:17

For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh: How much more shall the blood of Christ, **who through the eternal Spirit** offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? Hebrews 9:13-14

And he is **before all things**, Colossians 1:17a

**Everlasting: continuous existence; lasting or enduring through all time**

But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; **whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting**. Micah 5:2

Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even **from everlasting to everlasting, thou art God**. Psalm 90:2

**The Lord reigneth**, he is clothed **with majesty**; the Lord is clothed **with strength**, wherewith he hath girded himself: the world also is stablished, that it cannot be moved. **Thy throne is established of old: thou art from everlasting**. Psalm 93:1-2

For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called **Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace**. Of the increase of his government and peace **there shall be no end**, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth **even for ever**. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this. Isaiah 9:6-7

Forasmuch as **there is none like unto thee, O Lord; thou art great, and thy name is great in might**. Who would not fear thee, O **King of nations**? for to thee doth it appertain: forasmuch as **among all the wise men of the nations, and in all their kingdoms, there is none like unto thee**. But they are altogether brutish and foolish: the stock is a doctrine of vanities. Silver spread into plates is brought from Tarshish, and gold from Uphaz, the work of the workman, and of the hands of the founder: blue and purple is their clothing: they are all the work of cunning men. But **the Lord is the true God, he is the living God, and an everlasting king**: at his wrath the earth shall tremble, and the nations shall not be able to abide his indignation. Thus shall ye say unto them, The gods that have not made the heavens and the earth, even they shall perish from the earth, and from under these heavens. **He hath made the earth by his power, he hath established the world by his wisdom, and hath stretched out the heavens by his discretion**. When he uttereth his voice, there is a multitude of waters in the heavens, and he causeth the vapours to ascend from the ends of the earth; he maketh lightnings with rain, and bringeth forth the wind out of his treasures. Every man is brutish in his knowledge: every founder is confounded by the graven image: for his molten image is falsehood, and there is no breath in them. They are vanity, and the work of errors: in the time of their visitation they shall perish. The portion of Jacob is not like them: for **he is the former of all things**; and Israel is the rod of his inheritance: **The Lord of hosts is his name**. Jeremiah 10:6-16

I thought it good to shew the signs and wonders that **the high God** hath wrought toward me. **How great are his signs! and how mighty are his wonders! his kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and his dominion is from generation to generation**. Daniel 4:2-3

And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the **everlasting gospel** to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people, Saying with a loud voice, **Fear God, and give glory to him**; for the hour of his judgment is come: **and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters**. ## **I AM THE CREATOR OF ALL THINGS**

**The Creator** of all things

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God **created**

### **Heaven and earth**

In the beginning God created **the heaven and the earth**. Genesis 1:1

And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters. And **God made the firmament**, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament: and it was so. **And God called the firmament Heaven**. Genesis 1:6-8a

And God said, Let the waters under the heaven be gathered together unto one place, and let the dry land appear: and it was so. And God called the dry land **Earth**; Genesis 1:9-10a

And the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth lifted up his hand to heaven, **And swore by him that liveth for ever and ever, who created heaven, and the things that therein are, and the earth, and the things that therein are**, and the sea, and the things which are therein, that there should be time no longer: Revelation 10:5-6

Ah Lord God! behold, **thou hast made the heaven and the earth** by thy great power and stretched out arm, and there is nothing too hard for thee: Jeremiah 32:17

**the Great, the Mighty God, the Lord of hosts, is his name**, Jeremiah 32:18b

And the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth lifted up his hand to heaven, And swore by him that liveth for ever and ever, **who created heaven, and the things that therein are, and the earth, and the things that therein are**, Revelation 10:5-6a

And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. **And God said, Let there be light: and there was light**. Genesis 1:2b, 3

Let them praise the name of the Lord: for **he commanded, and they were created**. Psalm 148:5

### **Day & Night**

And God saw the light, that it was good: and **God divided the light from the darkness**. And **God called the light Day**, and **the darkness he called Night**. Genesis 1:4-5

### **Sun, Moon & Stars**

And God said, Let there be **lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night**; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years: And let them be for lights in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth: and it was so. And **God made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: he made the stars also**. And God set them in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth, And to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the light from the darkness: and God saw that it was good. Genesis 1:14-18

## Seas

and the gathering together of the waters called he **Seas**: Genesis 1:10b

## Grass, herbs, and fruit trees

And God said, Let the earth bring forth **grass**, the **herb yielding seed**, and **the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself**, upon the earth: and it was so. Genesis 1:11

## Water creatures and fowls

And God said, **Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath life, and fowl that may fly above the earth** in the open firmament of heaven. And God created great whales, and every living creature that moveth, which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind, and every winged fowl after his kind: and God saw that it was good. Genesis 1:20-21

## Trees

And out of the ground made the Lord God to grow **every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food**; Genesis 2:9

## All living creatures, creeping things and beasts of the earth

And God said, **Let the earth bring forth the living creature** after his kind, **cattle**, and **creeping thing**, and **beast of the earth** after his kind: and it was so. And God made the beast of the earth after his kind, and cattle after their kind, and every thing that creepeth upon the earth after his kind: and God saw that it was good. Genesis 1:24-25

## Man and woman

And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: Genesis 1:26a

**So God created man** in his own image, in the image of God created he him; **male and female created he them**. Genesis 1:27

And the Lord **God formed man** of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul. Genesis 2:7

And the Lord God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof; **And the rib, which the Lord God had taken from man, made he a woman**, and brought her unto the man. And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man. Genesis 2:21-23

This is the book of the generations of Adam. In the day that **God created man**, in the likeness of God made he him; **Male and female created he them**; and blessed them, Genesis 5:1, 2a

**Of the Rock that begat thee thou art unmindful, and hast forgotten God that formed thee**. Deutoronomy 32:18

## Procreation

**And God blessed them, saying, Be fruitful, and multiply**, and fill the waters in the seas, and let fowl multiply in the earth. Genesis 1:22

So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. And God blessed them, **and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply**, and replenish the earth, Genesis 1:27-28a

And Adam knew Eve his wife; and she conceived, and bare Cain, and said, I have gotten a man from the Lord. Genesis 4:1

And God spake unto Noah, saying, Go forth of the ark, thou, and thy wife, and thy sons, and thy sons' wives with thee. Bring forth with thee every living thing that is with thee, of all flesh, both of fowl, and of cattle, and of every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth; that they may breed abundantly in the earth, and **be fruitful, and multiply** upon the earth. Genesis 8:15-17

### **All Things**

These are the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that **the Lord God made the earth and the heavens, And every plant of the field before it was in the earth, and every herb of the field before it grew:** for the Lord God had not caused it to rain upon the earth, and there was not a man to till the ground. Genesis 2:4-5

And when they heard that, they lifted up their voice to God with one accord, and said, Lord, thou art God, **which hast made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all that in them is:** Acts 4:24

Thou, even thou, art Lord alone; **thou hast made heaven, the heaven of heavens, with all their host, the earth, and all things that are therein,** the seas, and all that is therein, and thou preservest them all; and the host of heaven worshippeth thee. Nehemiah 9:6

**By the word of the Lord were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth.** He gathereth the waters of the sea together as an heap: he layeth up the depth in storehouses. Let all the earth fear the Lord: **let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him. For he spake, and it was done; he commanded, and it stood fast.** Psalm 33: 6-9

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. **All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.** John 1:1-3

For **by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth,** visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: **all things were created by him, and for him:** Colossians 1:16

and **by him all things consist.** Colossians 1:17b

Through faith we understand that **the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.** Hebrews 11:3

### **Marriage: One Man, One Woman**

**Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.** Genesis 2:24

**I AM THE ONLY ONE WITH THE AUTHORITY & OMNISCIENCE (HAVING ALL KNOWLEDGE, ALL UNDERSTANDING & ALL WISDOM) TO SET RULES & GUIDELINES TO PROPERLY ORDER YOUR STEPS IN A WAY THAT IS PLEASING TO ME AND IN YOUR BEST INTEREST.**

And the Lord God **commanded** the man, Genesis 2:16

The steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord: and he delighteth in his way. Psalm 37:23

### **I AM THE AUTHOR OF PHYSICAL DEATH**

In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return. Genesis 3:19

Like as a father pitieth his children, so the Lord pitieth them that fear him. For he knoweth our frame; he remembereth that we are dust. As for man, his days are as grass: as a flower of the field, so he flourisheth. For the wind passeth over it, and it is gone; and the place thereof shall know it no more. Psalm 103:13-16

### **I AM THE AUTHOR OF REVENGE, AND THE ONLY ONE AUTHORIZED TO USE IT**

And the Lord said unto him, Therefore whosoever slayeth Cain, **vengeance** shall be taken on him sevenfold. Genesis 4:15a

Dearly beloved, **avenge not yourselves**, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, **Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.** Romans 12:19

### **I AM THE AUTHOR OF GRACE**

And the Lord said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them. **But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord.** Genesis 6:7-8

### **I AM THE ONE THAT CONTROLS THE WEATHER**

And God remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the cattle that was with him in the ark: and **God made a wind to pass over the earth**, and the waters asswaged; **The fountains also of the deep and the windows of heaven were stopped, and the rain from heaven was restrained;** And the waters returned from off the earth continually: and after the end of the hundred and fifty days the waters were abated. Genesis 8:1-3

Now it came to pass on a certain day, that he went into a ship with his disciples: and he said unto them, Let us go over unto the other side of the lake. And they launched forth. But as they sailed he fell asleep: and there came down a storm of wind on the lake; and they were filled with water, and were in jeopardy. And they came to him, and awoke him, saying, Master, master, we perish. **Then he arose, and rebuked the wind and the raging of the water: and they ceased, and there was a calm.** And he said unto them, Where is your faith? And they being afraid wondered, saying one to another, What manner of man is this! **for he commandeth even the winds and water, and they obey him.** Luke 8:22-25

### **I AM IN CONTROL OF THE HEAVEN & EARTH'S EXISTENCE**

And the Lord smelled a sweet savour; **and the Lord said** in his heart, **I will not again curse the ground any more for man's sake;** for the imagination of man's heart is evil from his youth; **neither will I again smite any more every thing living, as I have done.** **While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease.** Genesis 8:21-22

And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? and **what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world?** And **Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.** For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many. And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and

pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places. All these are the beginning of sorrows. Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake. And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another. And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many. And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold. But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. **And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.** When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:) Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains: Let him which is on the housetop not come down to take any thing out of his house: Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes. And woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days! But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day: For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be. And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened. Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here is Christ, or there; believe it not. For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect. Behold, I have told you before. Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, he is in the desert; go not forth: behold, he is in the secret chambers; believe it not. For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. For wheresoever the carcase is, there will the eagles be gathered together.

Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken: And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other. Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is nigh: So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors. Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled. **Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.**

**But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only.**

But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left. Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left. Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come. But know this, that if the goodman of the house had known in what watch the thief would come, he would have watched, and would not have suffered his house to be broken up. **Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.** Matthew 324:3-44

### **I AM THE POSSESSOR OF HEAVEN & EARTH**

**And Melchizedek king of Salem** brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God. And he blessed him, and **said, Blessed be Abram of the most high God, possessor of heaven and earth:** And blessed be the most high God, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And he gave him tithes of all. And the king of Sodom said unto Abram, Give me the persons, and take the goods to thyself. **And Abram said to the king of Sodom, I have lift up mine hand unto the Lord, the most high God, the possessor of heaven and earth,** Genesis 14:18-22

## **I AM THE ONE WHO HAS ESTABLISHED & UPHELD MY COVENANT WITH MANKIND**

And **I will establish my covenant with you**; neither shall all flesh be cut off any more by the waters of a flood; neither shall there any more be a flood to destroy the earth. **And God said, This is the token of the covenant which I make between me and you and every living creature that is with you, for perpetual generations:** I do set my bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a token of a covenant between me and the earth. And it shall come to pass, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the bow shall be seen in the cloud: **And I will remember my covenant**, which is between me and you and every living creature of all flesh; and the waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh. And the bow shall be in the cloud; and I will look upon it, that I may remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that is upon the earth. **And God said unto Noah, This is the token of the covenant, which I have established between me and all flesh that is upon the earth.** Genesis 9:11-17

## **I AM THE ONLY ONE THAT CAN MAKE OR ALLOW A MAN TO BECOME GREAT IN POWER, WEALTH & INFLUENCE**

**Now the Lord had said unto Abram**, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee: **And I will make of thee a great nation**, and I will bless thee, **and make thy name great**; and thou shalt be a blessing: And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed. **And the Lord appeared unto Abram, and said, Unto thy seed will I give this land:** and there builded he an altar unto the Lord, who appeared unto him. Genesis 12:1-3, 7

**And the Lord said unto Abram**, after that Lot was separated from him, Lift up now thine eyes, and look from the place where thou art northward, and southward, and eastward, and westward: **For all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed for ever.** And I will make thy seed as the dust of the earth: so that if a man can number the dust of the earth, then shall thy seed also be numbered. **Arise, walk through the land in the length of it and in the breadth of it; for I will give it unto thee.** Genesis 13:14-17

**And I will make my covenant between me and thee, and will multiply thee exceedingly.** And Abram fell on his face: and God talked with him, saying, As for me, behold, my covenant is with thee, **and thou shalt be a father of many nations.** Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham; **for a father of many nations have I made thee. And I will make thee exceeding fruitful, and I will make nations of thee, and kings shall come out of thee.** Genesis 17:2-6

For promotion cometh neither from the east, nor from the west, nor from the south. But God is the judge: he putteth down one, and setteth up another. Psalm 75:6-7

**And the Lord was with Joseph, and he was a prosperous man;** and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian. **And his master saw that the Lord was with him, and that the Lord made all that he did to prosper in his hand.** And Joseph found grace in his sight, and he served him: and he made him overseer over his house, and all that he had he put into his hand. **And it came to pass from the time that he had made him overseer in his house, and over all that he had, that the Lord blessed the Egyptian's house for Joseph's sake; and the blessing of the Lord was upon all that he had** in the house, and in the field. Genesis 39:2-5

And the keeper of the prison committed to Joseph's hand all the prisoners that were in the prison; and whatsoever they did there, he was the doer of it. The keeper of the prison looked not to any



thing that was under his hand; **because the Lord was with him, and that which he did, the Lord made it to prosper.** Genesis 39:22-23

And he said, **Peace be to you, fear not: your God, and the God of your father, hath given you treasure** in your sacks: I had your money. Genesis 43:23

**And God spake unto Israel** in the visions of the night, and said, Jacob, Jacob. And he said, Here am I. **And he said, I am God, the God of thy father: fear not to go down into Egypt; for I will there make of thee a great nation: I will go down with thee into Egypt; and I will also surely bring thee up again:** Genesis 46:2-4a

**And Israel dwelt in the land of Egypt, in the country of Goshen; and they had possessions therein, and grew, and multiplied exceedingly.** Genesis 47:27

### **I AM THE DEFINER OF LIFE**

**And the angel of the Lord said unto her, Behold, thou art with child, and shalt bear a son,** and shalt call his name Ishmael; because the Lord hath heard thy affliction. Genesis 16:11

### **I AM THE ALMIGHTY GOD**

And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the Lord appeared to Abram, and said unto him, **I am the Almighty God;** walk before me, and be thou perfect. Genesis 17:1

And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God. And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and **marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways,** thou King of saints. Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? for thou only art holy: for all nations shall come and worship before thee; for thy judgments are made manifest. Revelation 15:2-4

**The mighty God, even the Lord, hath spoken,** and called the earth from the rising of the sun unto the going down thereof. Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God hath shined. Psalm 50:1-2

Is any thing too hard for the Lord? Genesis 18:14a

### **I AM THE ONLY ONE THAT CAN KEEP YOU FROM SINNING AGAINST ME**

But God came to Abimelech in a dream by night, and said to him, Behold, thou art but a dead man, for the woman which thou hast taken; for she is a man's wife. But Abimelech had not come near her: and he said, Lord, wilt thou slay also a righteous nation? Said he not unto me, She is my sister? and she, even she herself said, He is my brother: in the integrity of my heart and innocency of my hands have I done this. And **God said unto him** in a dream, Yea, I know that thou didst this in the integrity of thy heart; for **I also withheld thee from sinning against me:** therefore suffered I thee not to touch her. Now therefore restore the man his wife; for he is a prophet, and he shall pray for thee, and thou shalt live: and if thou restore her not, know thou that thou shalt surely die, thou, and all that are thine. Genesis 20:3-7

### **I AM THE ONE THAT HEARS YOUR VOICE IN TIMES OF NEED**

And she went, and sat her down over against him a good way off, as it were a bowshot: for she said, Let me not see the death of the child. And she sat over against him, and lift up her voice, and wept. And God heard the voice of the lad; **and the angel of God called to Hagar out of heaven, and said**

**unto her, What aileth thee, Hagar? fear not; for God hath heard the voice of the lad where he is.** Arise, lift up the lad, and hold him in thine hand; for I will make him a great nation. And God opened her eyes, and she saw a well of water; and she went, and filled the bottle with water, and gave the lad drink. And God was with the lad; and he grew, and dwelt in the wilderness, and became an archer. Genesis 21:16-20

### **I AM THE ONE THAT LEADS YOU IN THE RIGHT WAY**

And I bowed down my head, and worshipped the Lord, and blessed **the Lord God of my master Abraham, which had led me in the right way** to take my master's brother's daughter unto his son. Genesis 24:48

### **I AM ALL KNOWING**

And Isaac intreated the Lord for his wife, because she was barren: and the Lord was intreated of him, and Rebekah his wife conceived. **And the children struggled together within her; and she said, If it be so, why am I thus? And she went to enquire of the Lord. And the Lord said unto her, Two nations are in thy womb, And two manner of people shall be separated from thy bowels;** and the one people shall be stronger than the other people; and the elder shall serve the younger. And when her days to be delivered were fulfilled, behold, there were twins in her womb. And the first came out red, all over like an hairy garment; and they called his name Esau. And after that came his brother out, and his hand took hold on Esau's heel; and his name was called Jacob: and Isaac was threescore years old when she bare them. Genesis 25:21-26

### **I AM THE ONE THAT SEES YOU IN YOUR AFFLICTION**

**And when the Lord saw that Leah was hated, he opened her womb:** but Rachel was barren. And Leah conceived, and bare a son, and she called his name Reuben: for she said, Surely the Lord hath looked upon my affliction; Genesis 29:31

**And the angel of God spake unto me in a dream, saying, Jacob:** And I said, Here am I. And he said, Lift up now thine eyes, and see, all the rams which leap upon the cattle are ringstraked, speckled, and grisled: for **I have seen all that Laban doeth unto thee.** Genesis 31:11-12

And Joseph called the name of the firstborn Manasseh: **For God, said he, hath made me forget all my toil,** and all my father's house. And the name of the second called he Ephraim: **For God hath caused me to be fruitful in the land of my affliction.** Genesis 41:51-52

### **I AM THE ONE THAT CAN TAKE WHAT IS MEANT FOR EVIL AND TURN IT INTO GOOD**

And Joseph's master took him, and put him into the prison, a place where the king's prisoners were bound: and he was there in the prison. **But the Lord was with Joseph, and shewed him mercy, and gave him favour in the sight of the keeper of the prison.** Genesis 39:20-21

And Joseph said unto his brethren, Come near to me, I pray you. And they came near. And he said, I am Joseph your brother, whom ye sold into Egypt. **Now therefore be not grieved, nor angry with yourselves, that ye sold me hither: for God did send me before you to preserve life.** For these two years hath the famine been in the land: and yet there are five years, in the which there shall neither be earing nor harvest. **And God sent me before you to preserve you a posterity in the earth, and to save your lives by a great deliverance. So now it was not you that sent me hither, but God: and he hath made me a father to Pharaoh, and lord of all his house, and a ruler throughout all the land of Egypt.** Genesis 45:4-8

**And when Joseph's brethren saw that their father was dead, they said, Joseph will peradventure hate us, and will certainly requite us all the evil which we did unto him.** And they sent a messenger unto Joseph, saying, Thy father did command before he died, saying, So shall ye say unto Joseph, Forgive, I pray thee now, the trespass of thy brethren, and their sin; for they did unto thee evil: and now, we pray thee, forgive the trespass of the servants of the God of thy father. And Joseph wept when they spake unto him. And his brethren also went and fell down before his face; and they said, Behold, we be thy servants. **And Joseph said unto them, Fear not: for am I in the place of God? But as for you, ye thought evil against me; but God meant it unto good, to bring to pass, as it is this day, to save much people alive.** Now therefore fear ye not: I will nourish you, and your little ones. And he comforted them, and spake kindly unto them. Genesis 50:15-21

**I AM THE ONLY ONE THAT CAN TELL YOU THE TRUE MEANING OF MY WORDS**

And Joseph said unto them, **Do not interpretations belong to God?** Genesis 40:8b

And it came to pass in the morning that his spirit was troubled; and **he sent and called for all the magicians of Egypt, and all the wise men thereof:** and Pharaoh told them his dream; **but there was none that could interpret them** unto Pharaoh. Genesis 41:8

And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, I have dreamed a dream, and there is none that can interpret it: and I have heard say of thee, that thou canst understand a dream to interpret it. **And Joseph answered Pharaoh, saying, It is not in me: God shall give Pharaoh an answer of peace.** Genesis 41:15-16

**And Joseph said unto Pharaoh,** The dream of Pharaoh is one: **God hath shewed Pharaoh what he is about to do.** Genesis 41:25

And for that the dream was doubled unto Pharaoh twice; it is **because the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass.** Genesis 41:32

**And Pharaoh said unto his servants, Can we find such a one as this is, a man in whom the Spirit of God is? And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, Forasmuch as God hath shewed thee all this, there is none so discreet and wise as thou art:** Genesis 41:38-39

**Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.** Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but **which the Holy Ghost teacheth;** comparing spiritual things with spiritual. **But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.** 1 Corinthians 2:12-14

But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from **the simplicity that is in Christ.** 2 Corinthians 11:3

Thus saith the Lord, **Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, neither let the mighty man glory in his might, let not the rich man glory in his riches: But let him that glorieth glory in this, that he understandeth and knoweth me,** that I am the Lord which exercise lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these things I delight, saith the Lord. Jeremiah 9:23-24

### **I AM THE ONE THAT BESTOWS WISDOM ON THOSE THAT FEAR ME**

And Joseph said unto them the third day, This do, and live; **for I fear God**: Genesis 42:18

**The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom**: Psalm 111:10a

### **I AM THE ONE THAT PROVIDES FOR YOU**

And he blessed Joseph, and said, God, before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac did walk, **the God which fed me all my life long unto this day**, Genesis 48:15

Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment? Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they? Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature? And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin: And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. **Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith?** Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) **for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things.** But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof. Matthew 6:25-34

### **I AM THE ONE WHO GIVES STRENGTH**

Joseph is a fruitful bough, even a fruitful bough by a well; whose branches run over the wall: **The archers have sorely grieved him, and shot at him, and hated him: But his bow abode in strength, and the arms of his hands were made strong by the hands of the mighty God of Jacob**; Genesis 49:22-24a

**God is my strength and power**: and he maketh my way perfect. 2 Samuel 22:33

### **I AM THE ONE WHOM ALL BLESSINGS COME FROM**

Even by the God of thy father, who shall help thee; and **by the Almighty, who shall bless thee with blessings of heaven above, blessings of the deep that lieth under, blessings of the breasts, and of the womb**: The blessings of thy father have prevailed above the blessings of my progenitors **unto the utmost bound of the everlasting hills**: they shall be on the head of Joseph, Genesis 49:25-26a
